A letter from Treasurer Slavens:

Welcome to Canton Township. The Treasurer's Office is solely responsible for the receipt, deposit, control and disbursement of all receipts of the Township on a daily basis. The Treasurer's Office is located on the first floor of the Canton Administration Building.

Property taxes are levied on your taxable value, which is issued by the Assessor's Office every February. Property taxes are mailed out twice a year on July 1st (summer/ tax due September 14th), and December 1st (winter tax/due February 14th). No tax payments are accepted after February 28. Tax payments after February 28 are made payable only to the [Wayne County Treasurer](#).

Your Winter property taxes are a one-year tax, covering: Regional Educational Service Agency-Intermediate School District, Wayne County, Wayne County Jail, Huron Clinton Metropolitan Authority, Wayne County Parks, Canton Township, Canton Township Police, Canton Township Fire, Canton Township Library, Canton Township Road millage, Wayne County Community College (for the Van Buren and Wayne-Westland school districts only) Detroit Zoo, Detroit Institute of Arts, Administration Fee, Solid Waste Fee. There may be additional line items on your tax statement pertaining to special assessments.

Your Summer property taxes are a one-year tax covering the school district in which you reside: State Education Tax, School Debt/ (Ply Canton) (Wayne Westland) (Van Buren) Sinking fund (Van Buren), School Operating/ (Ply Canton); (Wayne Westland) (Van Buren) Schoolcraft Community College, Wayne County.

There are various ways to pay your property taxes, including: At our 24-hour secure drop box: Our drop box is located outside the main entrance of the Canton Township Administration building; At the window: We are open Monday through Friday, from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm; By mail: Send your check / money order to: Canton Township Treasurer; P.O. Box 87010; Canton, MI 48187; Pay online at <https://www.canton-mi.org>; Pay over the phone by calling our automated line at 833-679-1710 (credit and debit cards only plus an additional fee of 2.5% of the transaction); Sign up for [autopay](#) and have your taxes electronically paid from your account on the due date.

At our counter we accept cash, personal checks, bank checks, MasterCard, Discover, and Visa. There is a \$3.95 charge for debit/credit card use under \$160 and a 2.5% charge for credit card payments over \$160. This charge is levied by the banks.

Water/sewer rates are set and voted on by the Township Board once a year, in May.

Water bills are mailed out every other month (bimonthly). Residents who live north of Ford Rd. receive their bills on the first of even months (Feb., April, June, August, Oct., Dec.) and is due the last Wednesday of that month. Residents who live south of Ford Rd. receive their bills on odd months (Jan., March, May, July, Sept. Nov.).
